## Caseville Township Board Meeting June 1, 2020

Meeting called to order at 4:00 p.m. by Ben Willenberg.

Present: Ben Willenberg, Michelle Stirrett, Vicki Dufty, Laurie Marrocco and Jerry Platko.

No citizens were present.

**Motion** by Stirrett second by Dufty to approve the agenda, the May 4, 2020 Board minutes, Treasurer's Report and invoices in the amount of \$60,108.49. **Motion carried**.

No Public Comments on agenda items.

## Committee Reports: No formal minutes

Harbor Commission - applied for DNR grant to replace gas dock and equipment. Fire Association - Marine patrol can get gas from Harbor to handle emergencies.

**Lawnmower Purchase**: Willenberg reported that the lawnmower purchased was \$389 more than anticipated because it is a 54 inch. The quoted 48-inch blade mower was a special order and wouldn't be available until July. He has repaired the old mower and will store it on the Township property. Dufty's Lawn Care has been contracted to cut the front of the property excluding the back side of the ditch and the 3 acres intended for the Township Hall at a cost of \$3,000. They will cut the remainder of the property for an additional \$2,000. Consensus was to have them maintain the front of the property, and to have the back part (beyond the ditch) groomed as needed.

## Office Re-opening

Discussion was held on staffing the office full time beginning June 1. The building will remain locked and employees will be available by appointment. Use of the drop boxes will be encouraged. A policy for COVID compliance will be developed.

Building Inspector Report given.

**Supervisor Update:** (1) Willenberg stated that he has been doing the ordinance enforcement and would like to get someone to do enforcement. **Motion** by Marrocco second by Willenberg to hire Tom Tolles to enforce nuisance ordinances (from April through October) at a salary of \$3,500. **Motion carried.** 

**Sign Replacement:** The LED sign in front of the building is in need of replacement at a cost of \$25,500. Originally the cost was split between the City, School and Township. Discussion was held on the costs, benefit and placement of the sign. **Motion** by Platko second by Marrocco to not support the purchase of a new LED sign. **Motion carried.** 

Consensus was to place a port a john at the basketball courts this summer.
