Meeting called to order at 4:00 p.m. by Fred Busch.

**Supervisor Update:** (1) regulations on garbage containers will be reinforced through the website and newsletter, (2) tall grass and weed issues are ongoing, (3) at the last meeting, Representative Canfield was told of our concerns regarding Board terms expiring at the same time. He asked that the Board pass a resolution and he could work on the issue. MTA was contacted and will not support such an effort due to the fact that the laws were written to allow a local candidate to run for a higher office (County, State) and so that candidates name not appear more than once on a ballot, (4) there is now a list of people willing to serve on committees, and (5) the Post Office will be installing community mailboxes in neighborhoods free before October 1.
