Meeting called to order at 1:30 p.m. by Jim Kanary with the Pledge of Allegiance.

**Motion** by Morden second by Golsch to approve the August 4, 2015 minutes. **Motion carried.**

Lundberg and Morden reported on the MTA Planning and Zoning Seminar. Among the topics covered were medical marijuana and the Right to Farm Act. Lundberg stated that there is pending legislation regarding medical marijuana. This issue is not addressed on the current ordinance and can be inserted into the ordinance with the proper review after legislation is passed. He further stated that under the Right to Farm Act, farm activity in non-agricultural areas can continue in perpetuity.

**Ordinance Review:** Members reviewed the September 2015 updated version of the proposed ordinance. Discussion was held on commercial stables, increase in door height on accessory buildings, and onsite wind and solar systems. Lundberg will incorporate changes for a final draft for member review at the October meeting. An index and table of contents will be done after final review. After approval of the final document, the proposed ordinance will be sent to the Township Board for review. The document will be sent to the County Planning Commission for review after a public hearing is held.
